How to make up an assignment using a leniency ticket.

  - d. what was the title
  - e. what was the talk about

  - g. be sure to include good grammar and paper format and keep your write up to one page, double spaced.
  - h. turn in your report in-class or in the folder outside 375 Town Engineering Building with the leniency ticket attached to the report.
